Each season the programs need several assistant instructors to help with daily activities. We are currently accepting applications from qualified candidates. Here is important information about joining us for the coming 2026 season as an Assistant Instructor. If you are interested in this opportunity, you will need to meet the qualifications, and reply before **April 27<sup>th</sup>** to be considered. Please review all of this information with your parents. Make sure you are diligent in turning in your paperwork.

In return for volunteer service as an assistant instructor during the season, successful candidates receive a reduced program tuition of \$250.00 for each session and the initial uniform is provided at no cost. Although this process is structured similar to an employment, candidates should not be intimidated. Everyone will gain from this win-win experience.

### Minimum Qualifications:

1. Have reached at least 14 years of age by the first day of selected program.
2. Have completed the A Group at CAJG, or other equivalent experience.
3. Willingness to learn from the instructors.
4. Proficient skills in aquatic environment.

### Desirable Qualifications:

1. Show strong leadership qualities and an ability to take initiative.
2. Possess the qualities and abilities of a prospective lifeguard with willingness to learn.
3. Willingness to volunteer time to make our programs a success for all participants.
4. Capable of working with youth and lead by example.
